This program allows early-career nursing researchers (mentees) to receive mentoring in English from experts in nursing research (mentors). The goal is to promote international activities and exchanges for early career nursing researchers, contributing to the development of nursing science and the career advancement of these young professionals.

About the Mentorship Program

The Mentorship Program pairs senior nursing researchers (mentors) with early career nursing researchers (mentees) to provide guidance and support in nursing research and career development. Mentors assist mentees in resolving work-related issues, fostering growth, and improving the research environment.

Expected Benefits

- Increased motivation for early career researchers
- Growth for both mentees and mentors
- Sharing of knowledge and experience
- Promotion of networking among nursing researchers

Consultation Details

Online meetings up to once a month discuss nursing research, education, and clinical practice.

The 1st meeting includes committee members; subsequent meetings are between mentor and mentee only.

Eligibility for Mentees

Regular members within 10 years of completing their doctoral program (excluding graduate students) Conversational-level English proficiency

Program Duration

Up to two years, from November 2024 to October 2026
